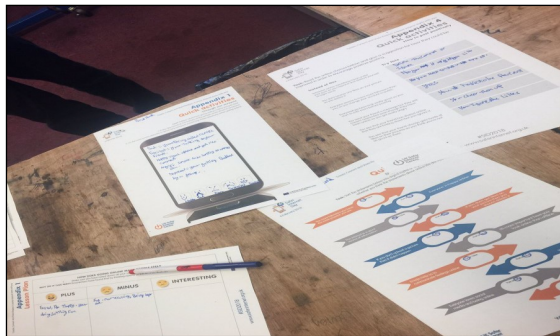




STAYING SAFE ONLINE
